MEA INFORMATION

Students in grades 3-8 at our school are scheduled to take the Maine Education Assessment (MEA) during the weeks of March 18 thru April 12, 2019. This is the annual state assessment that we are required to give to our students. The test provides families, school and state with information on student progress in math, reading and writing. There are seven segments to the test and the testing sessions, that will be spread out over several days, will span over 6+ hours.

Our school does value the information gained from this assessment. It provides a common assessment given to all students in a grade level and provides our only source of comparative information between grades, schools and within the state. It also is a third source of data that we use to help us determine how well we and our students are doing. We use classroom assessments, different forms of assessments from educational companies, and the MEA for this purpose.

In connection with the Every Child Succeeds Act, Maine is required to have at least 95% of all students in grades 3-8 and 11 participate in the MEA. This includes our school, and the potential for Title I funds being withheld is possible should our school not achieve this participation benchmark.

If you have any questions or are concerns about this assessment please contact Mr White.
